Stroud Brewery began in 2006, renting a small unit in Thrupp, on the edge of Stroud. Founder Greg Pilley set out with a vision to brew delicious beer with integrity - a thriving enterprise that would support the community, the environment and other local businesses. In Summer 2018, the brewery launched a £1,000 investment bond, aimed at local residents and customers. The aim was to raise £300,000 over three months to help finance the move to a new site – and the target was achieved within a week. This brewery truly is a community enterprise with great tasting beer to boot! This is an easy drinking 4.5% stout. Velvet on the palate with a complexity of fruity dark malt flavours to follow.



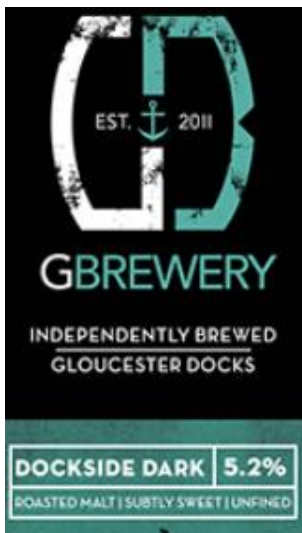
### Hillside Brewery Legless Cow

Founded in 2014, Hillside are based near Longhope in the Forest of Dean and are already building a reputation for award-winning beers. Inspired by our nation's finest traditions, this 4.2% Best Bitter has a rich caramel flavour with a smooth citrus hop finish. Awarded Silver in the Taste Of The West Awards – and Beer Of The Festival at Oswestry Beer Festival!



### Gloucester Brewery Cascade

Brewing in the traditional warehouse location of Gloucester Docks since 2011, this brewery has won a string of awards – including the thumpingly delicious Cascade which was announced Champion Bitter by Gloucestershire CAMRA (Campaign for Real Ale). A bold, full bodied, fruity 4.2% Best Bitter. Floral, hoppy and spicy.



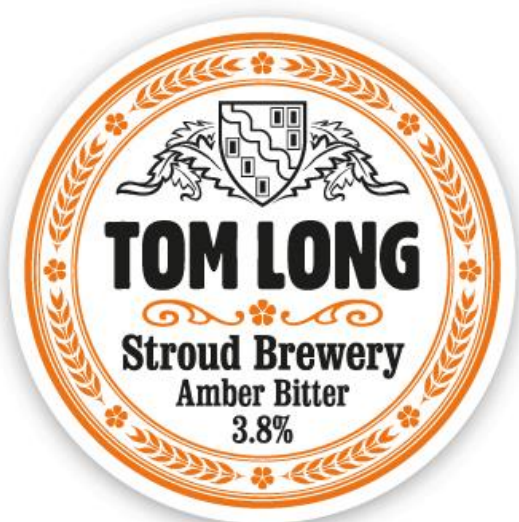
### Gloucester Brewery Docks Dark

More awards followed for Gloucester Brewery when SIBA (Society of Independent Brewers) Wales and West presented Docks Dark with the prestigious Gold Award for Bottled Porters and Stouts. A smooth taste with subtle sweetness and coffee, chocolate & dark fruit aroma. 5.2% - you're in for a treat with this one!



### Hillside Brewery Legend of Hillside

Founded in 2014, Hillside are based near Longhope in the Forest of Dean and are already building a reputation for award-winning beers. A superbly, traditional English 4.7% IPA with a subtle honey flavour balanced with earthy, spicy and orange hop flavours. Another award-winning beer from the Hillside Brewery: the hugely prestigious Beer Of The Year Silver from CAMRA (Campaign for Real Ale) – you really must try this one!



### Stroud Brewery Tom Long

Stroud Brewery is one of only a handful of solely organic brewers in the UK, with nearly all of its malt and barley sourced from within 15 miles of the brewery. This beer is named after a local highwayman, who is commemorated by Tom Long's Post which is located at the central crossroads on Minchinhampton Common – legend has it this is the spot where he was hanged. This is an amber session beer with spicy citrus aroma. Good body for low ABV. A great brew for the modern highwayman! Silver at SIBA National Beer Competition, Champion Bitters (up to 4.0%).
