

**Lost & Grounded** Keller Pils 4.8% abv



**Lost and Grounded** is a brewery on the banks of the River Avon in Bristol, established in July 2016. They say they are fascinated by the precision of German brewing and the idiosyncratic nature of Belgian beers – and are one of the few craft breweries who specialise in pilsners, lagers and other light beers.

**Keller Pils** is their bestseller - they take Pilsner malt from Germany and combine with three traditional hop varieties: Magnum, Perle and Hallertuaer Mittelfruh.

**Kellerbier** is a type of German beer which literally translates as "cellar beer", referring to its cool lagering temperatures. Brewed since the Middle Ages, Kellerbier contains more of its original brewing yeast, as well as vitamins, held in suspension. It is described by German producers as *naturtrüb* (naturally cloudy).

*P.S. L&G beers contain no isinglass finings, are vegan friendly and naturally hazy.*



**Wye Valley Brewery** Golden Ale 4.2% abv

**Wye Valley Brewery** is a brewery in the village of Stoke Lacy, Herefordshire (to the north-east of Hereford). Founded in 1985 by Peter Amor, it has become one of Britain's leading independent breweries.

**Golden Ale** is a welcome ray of liquid sunshine whether it's summer, winter or anywhere in between. Blended from two of Herefordshire's finest hop varieties, Goldings and the classic Fuggles, with Maris Otter pale malt to make this a cheerfully down-to-earth-beer that is simply bursting with zest and character.

**Great Western Brewing Co** Bengal Bay 5.0% abv

Founded in 2007, the **Great Western Brewing Co** is based in Hambrook in Bristol.

**Bengal Bay** is a traditional English-Style IPA, made with English malt & hops. It is gold in colour, with a lemony citrus aroma, tropical fruit notes and a dry, bitter-sweet finish. Perfect with spicy food!

### Burke's Beers Shin Kickers 4.5% abv

**Burke's Beers** is named after owner/brewer Samantha Burke (Sam) and brewed in the beautiful village of Blockley in the Cotswolds. It is a very small brewery, nano, in fact and she brews, bottles and labels everything by hand. The beers are made traditionally with love and care, conditioned in the bottle and are unfiltered and unfiltered so just the basic ingredient. Sam uses only British malts, hops and yeast and even the bottles are made in Britain. All the grain goes to a local farm and the hops are composted.

**Shin Kickers** Pale Ale is named after one of the events in the world-famous Cotswold Olimpicks held in Chipping Campden every year just down the road from the brewery. It is a crisp and refreshing pale ale, lovingly made in small batches. Unfiltered and unfiltered to develop its natural flavours, it is then conditioned in the bottle to create the carbonation. To be enjoyed chilled, but do pour gently as it contains some sediment. *Suitable for vegans.*



### Pershore Brewery Croft Ale 4.2% abv

**Pershore Brewery** is based on the outskirts of the picturesque Georgian town of Pershore near Worcester and is owned and run by husband and wife team, Sean and Elizabeth Barnett. We were welcomed with open arms at their recent open evening and thoroughly recommend their great range of beers.

**Croft Ale** is a bitter pale ale, mashed with pale and crystal malts, and three varieties of hops – cascade, chinook (a very popular hop!) and willamette. This is a medium-bodied session ale. This really is one to try!



### Beat Brewery Funk 5.5% abv

**Beat Brewery** was founded with a mission to unite their love of music and beer. Each of their beers has been paired with a music genre and is brewed with the beats on LOUD!

Packed with New World hops, **Funk**, is bursting with tropical and citrus notes guaranteed to get your groove on when the bassline drops. Dedicated to the funk warriors of the 20th century, Beat's signature IPA will have you dreaming of bellbottoms and dance floor fillers faster than you can say "play that funky music". Colossal tropical hop flavours with a simple malt base.
