



Lost & Grounded Long Story Short 3.5% abv

Lost and Grounded is a brewery on the banks of the River Avon in Bristol, established in July 2016. They say they are fascinated by the precision of German brewing and the idiosyncratic nature of Belgian beers – and are one of the few craft breweries who specialise in pilsners, lagers and other light beers.

Long Story Short is a ‘table’ beer or ‘small’ beer. There’s nothing small about the taste though! Table beer is a low ABV, light-bodied, light-coloured beer that aims to please all, typically enjoyed with food among friends.

Long Story Short is biscuity, with a malt base from 50% Belgian pale ale malt. It has additions of Columbus, Azacca, El Dorado and Centennial hops, giving floral and lemon flavours. It is palatable, smooth, and complimentary.

P.S. L&G beers contain no isinglass finings, are vegan friendly and naturally hazy.



Fierce & Noble Session IPA 4.2% abv

Fierce & Noble is a brewery in the St Werburghs area of Bristol, just off the M32. Founded in 2017, they describe themselves as committed to brewing modern, seasonal beer.

Session IPA is packed full of hops providing a powerful citrus punch that takes over the taste buds leaving you wanting another sip. This is a beer for the many, no matter your craft credentials. If you're in need of refreshment, Session has got you!



Hillside Brewery Jolly Jester 9.0% abv

Founded in 2014, **Hillside Brewery** are based near Longhope in the Forest of Dean and are already building a reputation for award-winning beers.

Jolly Jester is a fresh and fruity Belgian Tripel style beer, made using the brand new British Jester hop, which has limited & rare availability. A delicious combination of peardrop, spiced banana and caramel flavours. Far too drinkable for a 9% beer!





Gloucester Brewery Got Any ID? 6.4% abv

Brewing in the traditional warehouse location of Gloucester Docks since 2011, **Gloucester Brewery** has won a string of awards including overall champion in the small pack (bottle and can) competition with Gloucester Gold at the 'Wales & West' beer competition, run by The Society of Independent Brewers (SIBA).

Got Any ID? is a New Zealand IPA brewed in collaboration with Padstow Brewery. It is full bodied with a light bitterness and clean and floral finish. This can release continues the work of Padstow Brewery with Falmouth University Students who produce fantastic artwork to combine with fantastic beer.

Moor Beer Return of the Empire 5.7% abv

Moor Beer Brewery is based in Bristol, within walking distance of Temple Meads railway station. They also have a taproom located in Bermondsey, London.

Return of the Empire is an English IPA brewed using the British Jester hop. The name refers to the return of British hops - no longer are new world hops the only ones strong enough to hold your loyalty. Modern English hops are having a big impact – bolder, brighter and more powerful than before. Light caramel honey malt with honeydew melon, citrus, apricot and peach. This really is one to try!
