

Lost & Grounded Long Story Short 3.5% abv



Lost and Grounded is a brewery on the banks of the River Avon in Bristol, established in July 2016. They say they are fascinated by the precision of German brewing and the idiosyncratic nature of Belgian beers – and are one of the few craft breweries who specialise in pilsners, lagers and other light beers.

Long Story Short is a ‘table’ beer or ‘small’ beer. There’s nothing small about the taste though! Table beer is a low ABV, light-bodied, light-coloured beer that aims to please all, typically enjoyed with food among friends.

Long Story Short is biscuity, with a malt base from 50% Belgian pale ale malt. It has additions of Columbus, Azacca, El Dorado and Centennial hops, giving floral and lemon flavours. It is palatable, smooth, and complimentary.

Tiny Rebel Cali APA 5.6% abv



Tiny Rebel began in 2012 as two guys in a garage. They’ve grown a lot since then, now being a bespoke brewery with thousands of fans. This award-winning brewery is in Newport, South Wales. They are the youngest and only Welsh brewery to win Champion beer of Britain. They are the only brewery to have won gold, silver and bronze in the Champion Beer of Wales competition (in their first year!) and the only brewery to defend a gold the following year.

Cali APA is a super juicy extra hopped pale ale. All the hops give you a grapefruit and pineapple nose that is backed up by a fruity taste and rounded mouth feel. The finish is dry but not too much and it certainly is a sessionable 5.6%.

Binghams Brewery Brickworks Bitter 4.2% abv



Binghams Brewery on Tavistock Estate is built on the site of the Cotterel Brickworks which closed in 1939. The brewery opened its doors in 2010 and is located in the Berkshire village of Twyford. Since then, Owner & Head Brewer Chris Bingham has been brewing nothing but quality beers!

Brickworks Bitter is a malty bitter which is chestnut in colour with a slightly nutty hint. Hops balance the maltiness to provide a well rounded best bitter.





Moor Beer Company Revival 3.8% abv

Moor Beer Brewery is based in Bristol, within walking distance of Temple Meads railway station. They also have a taproom located in Bermondsey, London.

Revival is a very hoppy and refreshing bitter, brewed to celebrate the revival of the brewery, and meant to revive you when you need it. Light in colour but not flavour thanks to a blend of Pale, Lager, Cara, Crystal and Wheat malts. The hops are a blend of American varieties, with American-style yeast providing a crisp finish. For a beer relatively low in alcohol it has a very full flavour and drinks well above its strength, earning it a multitude of awards and setting the standard for the style. A modern classic!

Box Steam Soul Train 4.0% abv

Back in Brunel's day, some believed the sound and motion of a locomotive could trigger passengers' dark desires and cause instant insanity...

Those shady characters should have let off steam with a pint of **Soul Train**.

Driven by a desire for something new, **Box Steam's** IPA updates the classic recipe and brings the ABV down to session levels. An IPA with a pleasant fruit salad aroma, **Soul Train** has a smack of Mosaic hop flavour that particularly brings out characteristics of bubblegum and tropical fruit.



Chadlington Brewery Boat Race Lager 5.0% abv

Boat Race provides all the refreshment of a great pilsner with a well-balanced hop aroma, bitterness and crisp finish. Hopped with noble hops and brewed using only the finest English malt.

Chadlington Brewery have brought a hint of the Oxfordshire countryside to this classic European-style lager. Best enjoyed chilled and only when you're back on dry land!
