



Chadlington Brewery Golden Ale 4.0% abv

Chadlington Brewery is known as The Oxford Beer. Taking their inspiration from the glorious Oxfordshire countryside, they create great tasting beers that everyone can enjoy. Brewed using only natural ingredients including Oxfordshire spring water and the finest English hops and malt, Chadlington Brewery take their time to ensure each and every brew is the best it can be. They also work hard to leave the smallest carbon footprint possible. The hot water in the brewery is provided by renewable heat sources and spent grains are used as animal feed on farms in Oxfordshire and surrounding counties.

Golden Ale is a gloriously deep gold colour with hints of citrus and a zesty, slightly sweet finish.



Hop Back Brewery Taiphon 4.2% abv

Hop Back Brewery began in 1986 in the cellar of The Wyndham Arms in Salisbury. From the very beginning, the quality of the beer proved a hit with local drinkers and The Wyndham Arms has appeared in the CAMRA Good Beer Guide every year since.

Taiphon is a pale, thirst-quenching ale with a distinctly hoppy yet flowery palate. The addition of coriander and lemongrass give a zingy flavour, making this beer an ideal accompaniment to spicy dishes. *Gluten free.*



Shakespeare Brewing Co. Tempest 5.2% abv

A brand inspired by the great bard, The **Shakespeare Brewing Company** has scripted 3 premium ales, each one named after one of his famous plays. The range include a brown ale, Macbeth, a golden ale, Tempest and a dark ruby ale Othello.

The Tempest is a refreshing, vibrant golden ale that will caress your taste buds with citrus subtlety. *'Such stuff as dreams are made on'*

Burke's Beers Shin Kickers 4.5% abv

Burke's Beers is named after owner/brewer Samantha Burke (Sam) and brewed in the beautiful village of Blockley in the Cotswolds. The beers are made traditionally with love and care, conditioned in the bottle and are unfinned and unfiltered. Sam uses only British malts, hops and yeast and even the bottles are made in Britain. All the grain goes to a local farm and the hops are composted.

Shin Kickers Pale Ale is named after one of the events in the world-famous Cotswold Olimpicks held in Chipping Campden every year. It is a crisp and refreshing pale ale, lovingly made in small batches. To be enjoyed chilled, but do pour gently as it contains some sediment. *Suitable for vegans.*



Wishbone Brewery Dassler 4.2% abv

Wishbone Brewery is a microbrewery based in the heart of Yorkshire between Wuthering Heights and the Yorkshire Dales. The brewery is in an old industrial area of Keighley in the shed of a textiles mill. They aim to brew flavoursome beers in a broad range of styles and we certainly think they are easily meeting their aim.

Dassler is a New Zealand Helles Lager hopped with Motueka. Dassler is aged (lagered) for 6 weeks and is unfinned and unfiltered.

Tintagel Brewery Merlin's Muddle 5.2% abv

Tintagel Brewery is situated up on the hills above Tintagel on Condolden Farm, the highest Farmhouse in Cornwall. Originally set up in an old and redundant milking parlour, the environmentally friendly brewery is now housed in a state of the art, purpose-built facility. Tintagel Brewery use pure water from their own spring, rising 852 feet above the sea at Trebarwith Strand, and their very own wind turbine, to produce a suite of classic real ales.

We visited **Tintagel Brewery** whilst on a family holiday to Cornwall and were made to feel very welcome by Dave, Head Brewer and all the staff. Whilst we sampled the goods and enjoyed a tour, our daughter played in the on-site children's play park with her Grandma. The brewery is well worth a visit, not only for the fantastic beer but the epic cake! A beautifully decorated venue – we can understand why people even get married here!

Merlin's Muddle, is stronger, dark, full-bodied beer with a good balance between hops and malt and a clean, refreshing taste.
