



### Hillside Brewery Legless Cow 4.2% abv

Founded in 2014, **Hillside Brewery** are based near Longhope in the Forest of Dean and are already building a reputation for award-winning beers.

Inspired by our nation's finest traditions, the **Legless Cow** has a rich caramel flavour with a smooth citrus hop finish.

Awarded Silver in the Taste Of The West Awards – and Beer Of The Festival at Oswestry Beer Festival!



### Brasserie Castelaine Ch'ti Blonde 6.4% abv

After brewing and fermentation, **CHTI** beer is kept for weeks in storage tanks. In the calm and cool (0°C) environment, the beer matures, develops a finer taste, perfects its aroma and acquires its natural and characteristic sparkles. Through this process, the beer obtains its balance, finesse and gleam.

We picked up this beauty whilst out in France watching the Tour De France. This beer goes down very well after a day in the sun watching the riders whizz by!



### Wye Valley Golden Ale 4.2% abv

**Wye Valley Brewery** is located in the village of Stoke Lacy, Herefordshire (to the north-east of Hereford). Founded in 1985 by Peter Amor, it has become one of Britain's leading independent breweries.

**Golden Ale** is a welcome ray of liquid sunshine whether it's summer, winter or anywhere in between. The brewers have blended two of Herefordshire's finest hop varieties, Goldings and Fuggles, with Maris Otter pale malt to make this a cheerfully down-to-earth-beer that is simply bursting with zest and character.





### Fierce and Noble Hello Nasty 4.4% abv

**Fierce & Noble** is a brewery in the St Werburghs area of Bristol, just off the M32. Founded in 2017, they describe themselves as committed to brewing modern, seasonal beer.

**Hello Nasty** is a crisp, refreshing session IPA finished with New England yeast, giving it aromas of lemon and stone fruit on the nose. A real easy-drinker that leaves your pallet refreshed with a dry, bitter grapefruit finish.



### Bingham's Brewery Space Hoppy 5.0% abv

**Bingham's Brewery** on Tavistock Estate is built on the site of the Cotterel Brickworks which closed in 1939. The brewery opened its doors in 2010 and is located in the Berkshire village of Twyford. Since then, Owner & Head Brewer Chris Bingham has been brewing nothing but quality beers!

**Space Hoppy IPA** is a pale golden ale and the hops impart a citrus flavour to make this beer hugely refreshing and ideal for accompanying most foods. The cask version of Space Hoppy IPA won the Strong Bitter category at the SIBA South East Beer Competition 2011.

### Pershore Brewery Croft Ale 4.2% abv

**Pershore Brewery** is based on the outskirts of the picturesque Georgian town of Pershore near Worcester and is owned and run by husband and wife team, Sean and Elizabeth Barnett. We were welcomed with open arms at their recent open evening and thoroughly recommend their great range of beers.

**Croft Ale** is a bitter pale ale, mashed with pale and crystal malts, and three varieties of hops – cascade, chinook (a very popular hop!) and willamette. This is a medium-bodied session ale. This really is one to try!
