




Ainsty Ales Flummoxed Farmer 4.0% abv

Ainsty Ales launched in 2014 in vibrant York. The brewery gains its inspiration from the old “York & Ainsty District Wapentake”, a medieval once self-governing area, dating back to the 1200’s.

Founder Andy Herrington, who is Ainsty born and bred, has created ‘**Flummoxed Farmer**’, a light Blonde Ale with a grapefruit and tropical nose, giving a refreshing and slightly hoppy dry finish.



Kettlesmith Brewing Co. Timeline 5.4% abv

Kettlesmith Brewing Company is a small, independent craft micro-brewery located in Bradford on Avon, just outside of Bath. They brew modern interpretations of a wide variety of beer styles and draw inspiration from their American and English backgrounds along with a love of Belgian beer.


Kettlesmith Brewing see beer as a serious alternative to wine and as such, they support their products with food pairing advice. **Timeline**’s recommended food friends are fried fish, Mexican dishes, bitter salad leaves and cheeses with bite. This award winning IPA (bronze at SIBA independent regional keg beer awards 2017) is hop-driven and elegant and allows the malt to share the limelight. American and English hops join hands for herbal, berry and citrus flavours.

Wishbone Brewery Zoikes 4.2% abv

Wishbone Brewery is a microbrewery based in the heart of Yorkshire between Wuthering Heights and the Yorkshire Dales. The brewery is in an old industrial area of Keighley in the shed of a textiles mill. They aim to brew flavoursome beers in a broad range of styles and we certainly think they are easily meeting their aim.

Boat Lane Free Fallen 5.1% abv

Based in Offenham, Worcestershire, **Boat Lane Brewery** is a hidden gem. Ian Hazeldene, Owner and Brewer spends much of his time tinkering with the brewing process and tries new recipes each week depending on the season and availability of local ingredients.

Late in 2018, we brought you Phantom Falls, an American Pale Ale with a hint of raspberry. We loved it so much, we are thrilled to bring you '**Free Fallen**', another beer with added raspberry, only this time, full of raspberry, giving a sharp flavour.

Hopback Brewery Crop Circle 4.2% abv

Hop Back Brewery began in 1986 in the cellar of The Wyndham Arms in Salisbury. From the very beginning, the quality of the beer proved a hit with local drinkers and The Wyndham Arms has appeared in the CAMRA Good Beer Guide every year since.

Crop Circle is a very clean, flaxen-coloured beer with wonderful thirst-quenching properties. The subtle blend of aroma and bittering hops give a crispness on the tongue which is delicately fruity, giving way to some dryness. The inclusion of flaked maize in the grist subtly hints at crisp corn flavours.

Beat Brewery Funk 5.5% abv

Beat Brewery was founded with a mission to unite their love of music and beer. Each of their beers has been paired with a music genre and is brewed with the beats on LOUD!

Packed with New World hops, **Funk**, is bursting with tropical and citrus notes guaranteed to get your groove on when the bassline drops. Dedicated to the funk warriors of the 20th century, Beat's signature IPA will have you dreaming of bellbottoms and dance floor fillers faster than you can say "play that funky music". Colossal tropical hop flavours with a simple malt base.
