**Pershore Brewery** is based on the outskirts of the picturesque Georgian town of Pershore near Worcester and is owned and run by husband and wife team, Sean and Elizabeth Barnett. We were welcomed with open arms at their recent open evening and thoroughly recommend their great range of beers.

A classic India **Pale Ale**, using English pale and crystal malts and English hops: Golding and Fuggles. This **Pale Ale** is amber in colour, has a delicate yet classic rounded flavour and a light floral aroma. This is a refreshing pale ale providing a refreshing hoppy taste.



### Shindigger IPL 5.5% abv


A juicy lager / IPA hybrid. **IPL** combines the crisp fermentation profile of a lager with the fruity hop profile of a New England IPA.

### Castle Rock Brewery Fruit v3 4.5% abv

Formed in 1977 as 'Tynemill' by former CAMRA Chariman Chris Holmes, **Castle Rock** has gone from strength to strength over the years, developing a reputation for excellent quality real ale.

This fruity number **Fruit v3** brings you Lychee, pear and orange. This modern brew combines the old and the new, pushing the Brewhouse to its limits. Was it worth the effort? We certainly think so!



### Pheasantry Brewery Excitra 4.5% abv

In 2012, **Pheasantry Brewery** converted their old farm building into a modern micro-brewery. The brewery's name is derived from the cottage next to the brewery which original maps show was a Pheasantry used for breeding and rearing game birds.

**Excitra** is bright golden-orange with a pungent punch and an expeditious use of the citra hop. A bold but balanced beer.

### Pelforth Brewery Pelforth Blonde 5.5% abv

**Pelforth** is a French brewery founded in 1914 in Mons-en-Barœul by three Lillois brewers. It was originally called Pelican, after a dance popular at the time, but changed its name to Pelforth after World War II. The name is a mash up of Pelican and "forte", which means strong – and this is the style of beer they brew, including a blonde, brune and amber.

It is their **Blonde** that we bring to you. We enjoyed this in the last of the summer sun while on a recent trip to the South of France. It is smooth and flavourful, enjoy!
