



### **GWB** Black Strap 7.0% abv

Founded in 2007, the **Great Western Brewing Co** is based in Hambrook in Bristol.

Bursting through the rafters with dark roasted malts, **Black Strap** has uncopious amounts of Molasses sugar and gives an almost brandy-like taste. It's dark, rich and thick. If the **Black Strap** doesn't keep you warm on a cold night... nothing will!



### **Shindigger** West Coast Pale Ale 4.5% abv

**Shindigger** was founded back in 2012 by Paul and George, students at the time studying in Manchester. They started with a home-brewing kit and brewed beers in the kitchen of their student flat. The name **Shindigger** embodies the ethos that beer is about having a good time with your friends and enjoying the moment!

Clean, crisp and pale with a burst of orange from the lead hop Amarillo. **West Coast Pale** is homage to the West Coast styles that dawned a new era in world brewing and inspired **Shindigger** to start brewing!

### **Wye Valley Brewery** Eskimo's Kiss 4.4% abv

**Wye Valley Brewery** is in the village of Stoke Lacy, Herefordshire (to the north-east of Hereford). Founded in 1985 by Peter Amor, it has become one of Britain's leading independent breweries.

This warming, malty winter brew has a biscuit base from Extra Pale Maris Otter, Munich, Amber and Crystal Malts. A balanced bitter finish follows, with Olicana - a new variety of Herefordshire-grown hop - delivering the flavours and aromas of mango and passionfruit.

**Boat Lane Brewery** Offenhams Orange 4.5% abv
