



Pershore Brewery Solstice Gold 3.8% abv

Pershore Brewery is based on the outskirts of the picturesque Georgian town of Pershore near Worcester and is owned and run by husband and wife team, Sean and Elizabeth Barnett. We were welcomed with open arms at their open evening and thoroughly recommend their great range of beers.

Solstice Gold is a golden ale, gently mashed with pure pale malts and three varieties of hops – Golding, Fuggles and Pilgrim. This is a light and refreshing ale, no matter what time of year you enjoy it.



Shindigger Shingri-La 6.5% abv

Shindigger was founded back in 2012 by Paul and George, students at the time studying in Manchester. They started with a home-brewing kit and brewed beers in the kitchen of their student flat. The name **Shindigger** embodies the ethos that beer is about having a good time with your friends and enjoying the moment!

Shingri-La is the biggest, baddest IPA in **Shindigger's** range. A three hop blend of Simcoe, Equinox and Mosaic.

Wye Valley Brewery Kaleidoscope 5.0% abv

Wye Valley Brewery is a brewery in the village of Stoke Lacy, Herefordshire (to the north-east of Hereford). Founded in 1985 by Peter Amor, it has become one of Britain's leading independent breweries.

A dizzily delightful dry-hopped and aromatic craft ale, **Kaleidoscope** boasts a blend of hops from New Zealand, giving this beer a mesmerising array of fruity flavours.



Alphabet Brewing Co Charlie Don't Surf 4.0% abv



Alphabet Brewing Co are a small Manchester based craft brewery focussed on making hop forward and original beers. They strive for quality and we really think their passion shows through the beers they produce

Derby Brewing Company Bald Eagle 4.5% abv

Derby Brewing Company started back in 2004 and have continued to make top quality beers ever since!

Bald Eagle is a golden pale ale with a well-rounded body and dry finish. It is hopped with buckets of Citra to provide a tropical fruit bouquet. It is then finally dry hopped to make it a real juice box.

Lost and Grounded Pale Ale 4.5% abv

Lost and Grounded is a brewery on the banks of the River Avon in Bristol, established in July 2016. They say they are fascinated by the precision of German brewing and the idiosyncratic nature of Belgian beers – and are one of the few craft breweries who specialise in pilsners, lagers and other light beers.

Lost and Grounded brewed their first ever Gose, a traditional thirst crushing north-German wheat beer! This collaboration brewed with Burnt Mill and Whiplash used a grist of 60% Wheat and 40% Pils malt and was soured with their house lactic culture. This beer has a subtle dose of coriander, a healthy amount of Irish sea salt to promote a smooth and round palate, and is dry-hopped with Sabro and Loral – it is tart, lemony and bright – bring on the sun!
