

### Tintagel Brewery Sir Lancelot 4.2% abv

**Tintagel Brewery** is situated up on the hills above Tintagel on Condolden Farm, the highest Farmhouse in Cornwall. Originally set up in an old and redundant milking parlour, the environmentally friendly brewery is now housed in a state of the art, purpose-built facility. Tintagel Brewery use pure water from their own spring, rising 852 feet above the sea at Trebarwith Strand, and their very own wind turbine, to produce a suite of classic real ales.

**Sir Lancelot** is a beautiful hoppy Pale Ale, with a nice bitter finish. A very well made beer.



### Pelforth Brewery Pelforth Blonde 5.5% abv

**Pelforth** is a French brewery founded in 1914 in Mons-en-Barœul by three Lillois brewers. It was originally called Pelican, after a dance popular at the time, but changed its name to Pelforth after World War II. The name is a mash up of Pelican and "forte", which means strong – and this is the style of beer they brew, including a blonde, brune and amber.

It is their **Blonde** that we bring to you. We enjoyed this in the last of the summer sun while on a recent trip to the South of France. It is smooth and flavourful, enjoy!


### Siren Craft Brew Santo 5.0% abv

**Siren Craft Brew** was born in 2013 with a simple idea in mind: to introduce exciting, full-flavoured and forward-thinking beers to as many people as possible.

**Santo** is a distinctly Siren lager. Their take on the style is full of American hops, working in harmony to offer subtle tropical fruit notes and bright citrus flavours. It pours with a delicate haze and a striking aroma. Sainly fresh, but devilishly drinkable.



**Pershore Brewery** CTRL-ALT-DELETE 5.2% abv



**Pershore Brewery** is based on the outskirts of the picturesque Georgian town of Pershore near Worcester and is owned and run by husband and wife team, Sean and Elizabeth Barnett. We were welcomed with open arms at their open evening and thoroughly recommend their great range of beers.

**CTRL-ALT-DELETE**, brewed with Pilsner grain and coloured by Cara and Caragold malts, has an abundance of high-alpha aroma hops. The Hop mixture provides a fruity, yet aromatic citrus flavour with undertones of mango and tropical fruits, and a floral hit on the nose.



**Derby Brewing Company** Blood Wolf 4.8% abv

**Derby Brewing Company** started back in 2004 and have continued to make top quality beers ever since!

Toasted caramel, sweet sticky toffee and bitter richness from intensely roasted malt and subtle spiciness of rye. Zesty pithiness and robust resin of new world hops. Bold and upfront with a twisted complexity.

**Teme Valley Brewery** This 3.7% abv

Because of the brewery's origins in farming, they only use UK grown malt and hops from Worcestershire and Herefordshire in their beers. With the exception of a Porter and an occasional wheat beer, all of their beers are "Burton" bitters – the style widely recognised as "real ale".

**This**, is all the easy drinking virtues of a light ale with a vivid hop aroma. Challenger and Goldings hops with a hint of chocolate malt make a memorable session beer.
