



**Gorgeous Brewery** Gunpowder 4.8% abv

**Gorgeous Brewery** is an independent, family run craft brewery in the heart of Highgate, London. Founded by brother sister duo, Rob and Sam Laub the brewery is focused on creating an eclectic, deliciously drinkable range with an emphasis on handcrafted quality.

The brewery works with little automation, so a whole lot of care and hard work goes into every brew. All beers, apart from the real ales, are unfiltered and unfiltered, which means they are vegan, retain a natural haze and even more flavour.

**Gunpowder IPA** has a strong malt base, an intense bitter finish and earthy, resinous and orange marmalade aromas.



**Lost and Grounded** Big Thaw 2 6.8% abv

**Lost and Grounded** is a brewery on the banks of the River Avon in Bristol, established in July 2016. They say they are fascinated by the precision of German brewing and the idiosyncratic nature of Belgian beers – and are one of the few craft breweries who specialise in pilsners, lagers and other light beers.


A while ago **Lost and Grounded** invited good pals **Burnt Mill Brewery** back to brew a new version of **BIG THAW** West Coast-style IPA! Dry, clean, bright and bitter, this IPA delivers piney, pithy, grapefruity goodness with doses of mango and papaya for good measure. An absolute cracker! They still think West Coast is the best coast!

**Quantock Brewery** Quantock Pale Ale 4.0% abv

**Quantock Brewery** was set up in December 2007 in Wellington, Somerset. However, it was born out of the love of brewing by head brewer Rob Rainey. Rob purchased his first home brew kit from Boots but when this didn't produce the quality of beer he wanted, Rob, a former nuclear engineer, built his own kit from scratch, and the rest is history.

**Quantock Pale Ale** is extremely light in colour, crafted using US hops, giving massive citrus flavour and aroma.





**Clavell & Hind** Coachman 3.8% abv

John **Clavell** and Captain James **Hind**, both infamous highwaymen, rode the coaching routes of England's South West, stopping at inns and public houses to quench their appetites, rest and plot. Knights of the road have been linked with drinking establishments for centuries. These heroic and courageous men were held in high esteem by the people, as stories of their daring spread fast across the country, engraining their name in English folklore.

**Coachman** is a golden ale brewed using English hops. It bridges the gap between lager and ale and is clean tasting and thirst quenching. A delightful sweet mouthfeel followed by a moreish bitterness leaving the drinker wanting more.



**Stonehenge Ales** Great Bustard 4.8% abv

All the brewing magic at **Stonehenge Ales** takes place in the Old Mill at Netheravon. The Old Mill is in the most idyllic setting imaginable on the bends of the River Avon. The Old Mill started life in 1914 as an electricity generator for the Netheravon Airfield using waterpower from the River Avon.

**Great Bustard** is a dark amber coloured beer with a deep red hue traditionally brewed using only the finest quality of Stonehenge Spring Water, barley, rye, crystal and wheat malts, whole hops and the brewery's own top-fermenting yeast. The complex malt and fruit flavours develop into a very pleasingly fruity and bitter aftertaste which lingers on. This fine beer was first brewed to celebrate the approval in November 2003 for the reintroduction of the Great Bustard bird onto the Salisbury Plain.

**Abbeydale Brewery** Voyager 5.6% abv

In 1996, when Patrick Morton along with his father Hugh decided to pursue their mutual love of fine beer and put their faith and money into creating their very own brewery. 24 years on, Pat and his wife Sue are still very much at the helm at **Abbeydale Brewery** and have developed the business into a well-known Sheffield institution.

**Voyager** is oozing juicy citrus and tropical fruit flavours with a vibrant finish. West Coast bitterness meets East Coast fruitiness.
