



Howling Hops Tropical Deluxe 3.8% abv

Howling Hops have been passionate about good beer for many years. Initially drinking it, then selling it at the Southampton Arms and eventually onto brewing it. In 2011, they reopened the Cock Tavern on Mare street as Hackney's first brewpub. They brewed over 100 different beers in the 'brew cave' over the course of 2 years, never brewing the same beer twice. They needed to expand again over in Hackney Wick and that's where they are today.

Howling Hops brew bold, modern, uncompromised, flavoursome, generously hopped beers. All their beers are unfiltered, unpasteurised and suitable for vegans.

Tropical Deluxe is Howling Hop's core pale ale. Citra, Mosaic and Simcoe do the tropical dry hop tango, while the mighty London Ale III yeast strain keeps things soft, light, and as level as a hammock. Lower in alcohol, deluxer in tropical.



Full Circle Brew Co Meridian Single Hop Pilsner 4.2% abv

Full Circle Brew Co are a brewery and tap room based in Hoult's Yard, Newcastle, within easy reach of the city centre, in the craft beer haven of the Byker, Walker and Ouseburn communities. Well worth a visit if you're ever in the area.

Meridian Single Hop Pilsner is the first in its series, celebrating the Hallertau Blanc hop. This offers drinkers a crisp and refreshing pilsner with subtle grapefruit and elderflower on the finish.

Quantock Brewery QBVE 4.3% abv

Quantock Brewery was set up in December 2007 in Wellington, Somerset. However, it was born out of the love of brewing by head brewer Rob Rainey. Rob purchased his first home brew kit from Boots but when this didn't produce the quality of beer he wanted, Rob, a former nuclear engineer, built his own kit from scratch, and the rest is history.

QBVE is a beer with distinctive British character, skilfully combining Jester and Olicana hops to produce wonderfully aromatic flavours. Pure liquid goodness.





No Heroes Eaglecan 5.0% abv

No Heroes is a social brewery founded by a small team who want to make a lasting difference to our planet and our life - that's why they are committing to plant a tree every time they make a sale with the great guys at one tree planted.

Eaglecan is a blend of 6 different malts coming together for a sweet, malty base, then rye malt is added for a soft, spicy undertone. Hopped with Centennial & Simcoe, expect those lovely classic grapefruit & pine notes.

Cotswold Brew Co Cotswold IPA 5.2% abv

Cotswold Brew Co is one of the oldest independent lager microbreweries in the UK, having now entered their 15th year of brewing.

Smooth, soft and malty - **Costwold IPA** is full-bodied with a distinctive hoppiness derived from a subtle mix of classic hops. Looks like liquid gold, tastes like hoppy greatness.

Howling Hops Secret Hotel 5.5% abv

Secret Hotel is a DDH Rye Pale Ale hopped with Cryo Citra, Enigma and Sabro. Super-pale, hazy and complex, with notes of berries, pineapple and coconut from the hops mingling with a sweet note of spice from the rye malt.
