

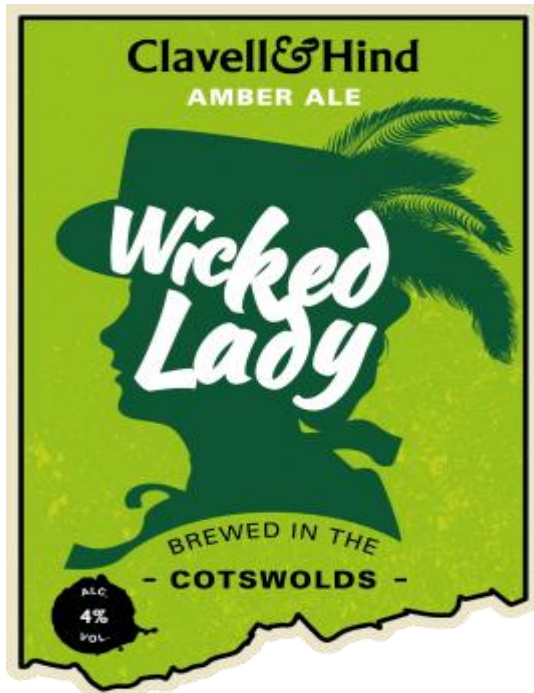
Two Tribes Dream Factory 4.4% abv

Clavell & Hind Wicked Lady 4.0% abv

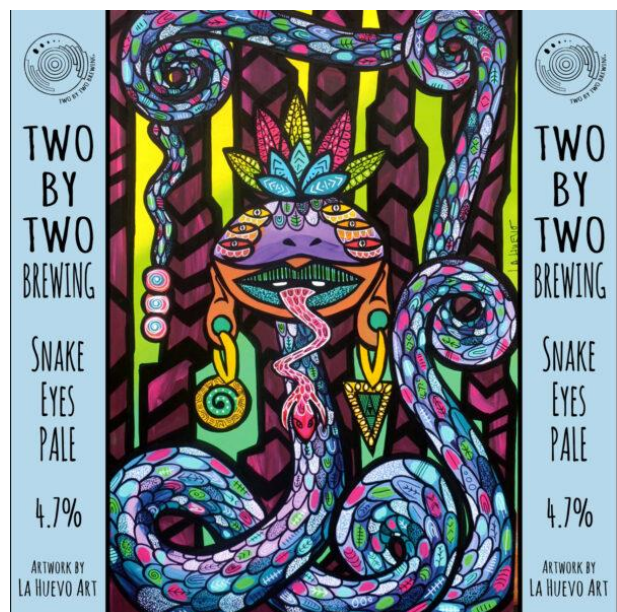

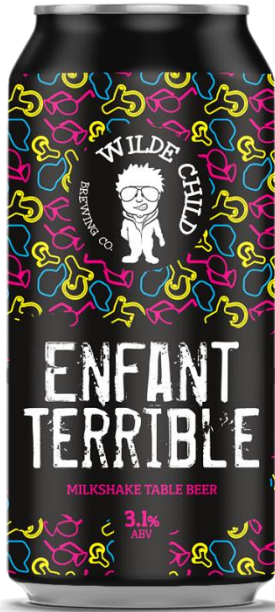
Wicked Lady is a modern amber ale. It is smooth and refined and has a subtle hint of toffee.

Back in 2010, armed with a couple of plastic buckets, some steriliser, some hosepipe and a malt extract kit, **Wilde Child** ventured into the world of beer making! After a huge amount of planning and preparation and 3 year's ahead of their intended plan, **Wilde Child Brewing Co.** was born.

A hefty amount of Citra, Simcoe and El Dorado hops cooked up with a healthy serving of lactose will have even the most avant-garde individual pondering over what they've just consumed. Here's to going against the grain, anti-conformism and being an outright 'Terrible Child'.



Cotswold Brewing Company 3.8 Pils Lager 3.8% abv

The **Cotswold Brew Co** story goes back to 2005. Their founders, Richard & Emma Keene went against the grain of the UK brewing industry by taking up a challenge that few others were attempting at the time: to start a brewery that would produce a high-quality British lager full of flavour – bringing new life to the style.

Pilsner re-imagined. Using a blend of aromatic New World hops, **3.8 Pils** is a light-bodied lager with real character. With flavours of grapefruit and pine, and a bittersweet finish, this is the refreshing beer to start your session with.

Little Monster Brewing Company Coast 5.6% abv

Little Monster Brewing Company of Chichester, West Sussex was founded by award winning brewer Brenden Quinn who has had a passion for locally produced craft beer since he was introduced to it when travelling in Canada back in 2000. At the beginning of 2018 Little Monster Brewing Company was born. The name came from Brenden's daughter who he calls affectionately, "my Little Monster". The name came instantly to Brenden as he wanted to dedicate all that he did to his little girl and the inspiration she gave him.
