

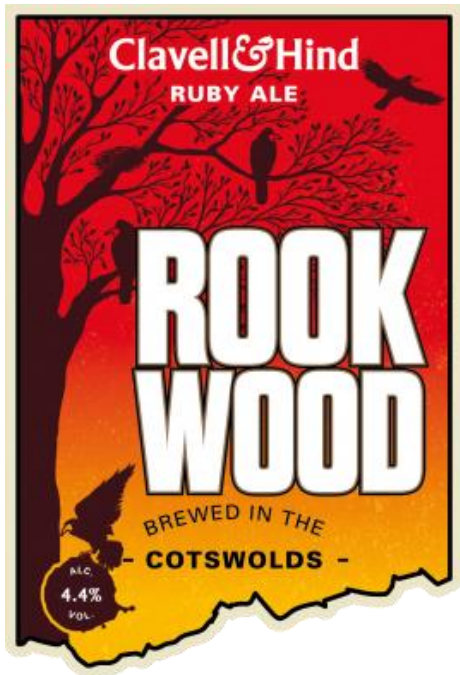
Salt Beer Factory Crash 5.0% abv

Clavell & Hind Rookwood 4.4% abv



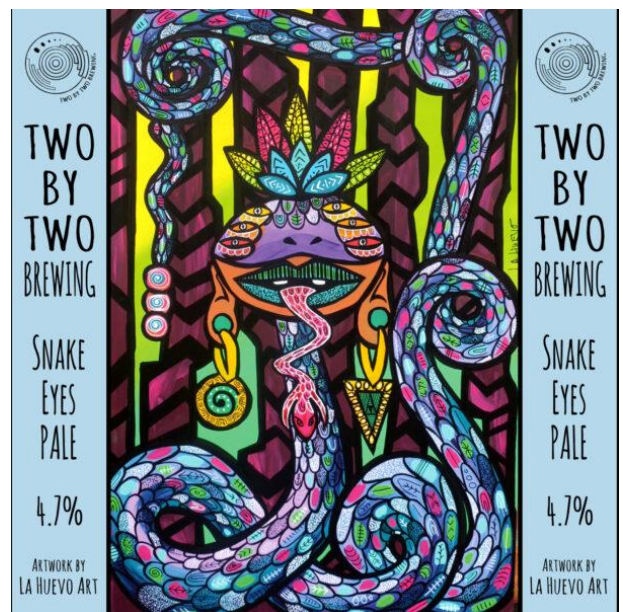

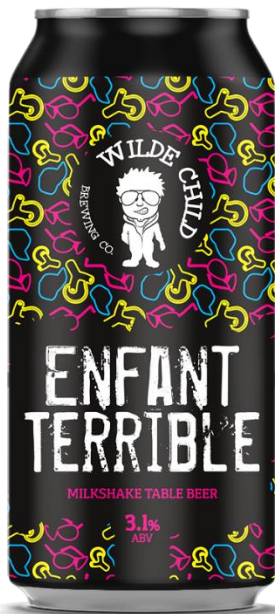
Rookwood is a rich Ruby Ale, copper in colour giving you flavours of dark fruit and treacle.

Two by Two Brewing Snake Eyes 4.7% abv

Back in 2010, armed with a couple of plastic buckets, some steriliser, some hosepipe and a malt extract kit, **Wilde Child** ventured into the world of beer making! After a huge amount of planning and preparation and 3 year's ahead of their intended plan, **Wilde Child Brewing Co.** was born.

A hefty amount of Citra, Simcoe and El Dorado hops cooked up with a healthy serving of lactose will have even the most avant-garde individual pondering over what they've just consumed. Here's to going against the grain, anti-conformism and being an outright 'Terrible Child'.



Hillside Brewery Legless Cow or Over The Hill 4.2% or 3.5% abv

Founded in 2014, **Hillside** are based near Longhope in the Forest of Dean and are already building a reputation for award-winning beers.

Inspired by our nation's finest traditions, the Best Bitter **Legless Cow**, has a rich caramel flavour with a smooth citrus hop finish.

Over The Hill is a full bodied, single-hop, malty dark mild, with our Bramling Cross hop complementing a cocoa & roasted malt character.

Frome Brewing Company Funky Monkey 4.0% abv

The brewing team at **Frome Brewing Company** are extremely talented and knowledgeable brewers that pride themselves on the highest quality beers. They do like to experiment but more importantly, its all about balancing delicate flavors to produce easy drinking beers.

Pour yourself a long tall glass of **Funky Monkey** and linger on the light amber gleam before taking in the captivating aromatics of ripe mango and freshly squeezed grapefruit on the nose thanks to Citra and Mosaic in the hop mix. There is more citrus and tropical fruit on the palate, which are balanced by a subtle bittersweetness, before finishing with a clean bitterness and lasting dryness that encourages you to take another sip.
