

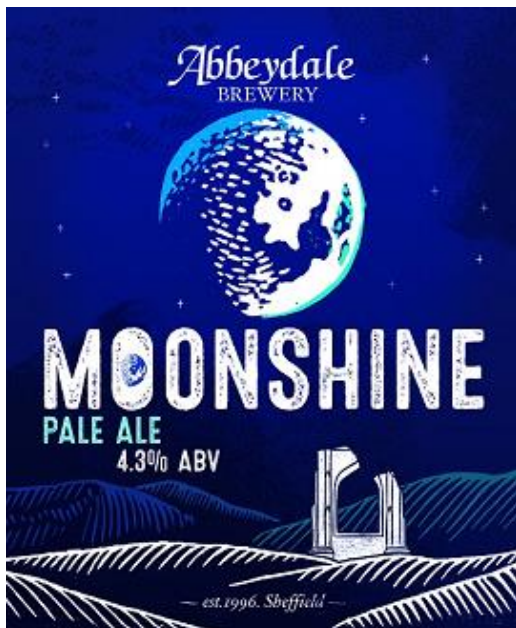
Two Tribes Metroland 3.8% abv

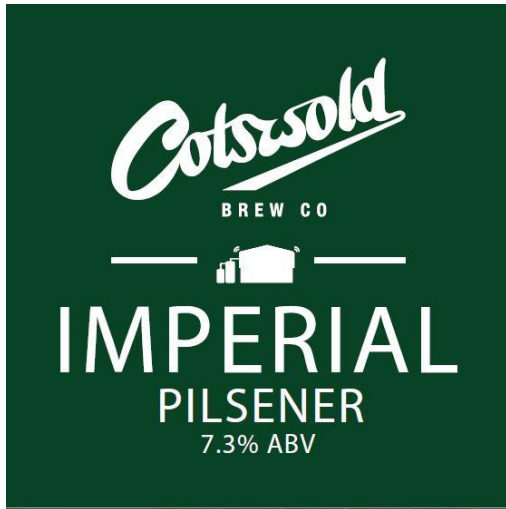
The flagship pale, and their most famous beer, **Moonshine** has been in production since way back in 1996, when the brewery led the path to America to experiment with hops never before seen in the UK. Now 25 years down the line and **Moonshine** is still a firm favourite across the board. Hopped with Willamette, Delta, Citra, Chinook & Centennial - this is a beautifully well balanced pale perfect for any occasion.

Salt Beer Factory Calico 4.0% or Crash 5.0% abv

Founded in 2018, the vision for **SALT** was 3 years in the planning. They aimed to create a modern, accessible brand, embedded in the local community of the UNESCO World Heritage Village of Saltaire. They strive to produce exceptional hop-forward beer and couple this with a valuable brand experience.

Cotswold Brew Co Imperial Pilsner 7.3% abv
