Established in 1999, **North Cotswold Brewery** is a great family-run craft brewery situated on the Fosseway a few miles outside Moreton in Marsh.

The Green Man also known as Jack of the Wood, and the brewery's emblem. It is believed to symbolise the "cycle of life" and our affinity with nature. Pale hoppy modern IPA.

Lost and Grounded Helles 4.4% abv



Lost and Grounded is a brewery on the banks of the River Avon in Bristol, established in July 2016. They say they are fascinated by the precision of German brewing and the idiosyncratic nature of Belgian beers – and are one of the few craft breweries who specialise in pilsners, lagers and other light beers.

In 2021 L&G welcomed **Helles** as a full-time addition to their core range. Gentle and balanced, Helles exemplifies everything they aim to achieve as lager brewers. Rolling hills, open fields and happy times with friends – a reminder there are good things ahead. Helles uses the same pilsner malt blend as Keller Pils, and gently hopped with Magnum, Perle and Tettnang. Soft, Bready, Floral.

Beermats Brewing Company Legitimate 4.5% abv

Beermats Brewing Company was founded in 2017 by 3 friends in a pub while drinking good, honest British beer – like most good ideas! This was when they decided what their brewing philosophy would be – easy drinking, great beer that's not too out-there that everyone can enjoy, whether it be on a Summer's day or by the fire during the cold of Winter.

Legitimate is a classic English bitter made using the best malt & English hops. Auburn coloured, with big malty flavours, gentle spicy notes & a lingering bitter finish.



Frome Brewing Company Rise of the Independents 4.8% abv



The brewing team at **Frome Brewing Company** are extremely talented and knowledgeable brewers that pride themselves on the highest quality beers. They do like to experiment but more importantly, its all about balancing delicate flavours to produce easy drinking beers.

New Zealand-grown Nelson Sauvín makes all the running in this juicy, light amber-hued IPA. Named because the hop variety's characteristics are reminiscent of Sauvignon Blanc (so that's wine drinkers covered), it has made itself very comfortable in each glass of this intriguing IPA. It has light and lilting suggestions of gooseberry and lemon on the nose, while a similar fruitiness tantalises the palate, alongside a dash of white pepper followed by an arch of bitterness and dryness in the finish.

Red Rock Brewery Back Beach 3.8% abv



Red Rock is a family run brewery based on a farm in South Devon, South West England. Since 2006, they've been making an extensive range of award winning and quality real ales and beers using the finest natural ingredients and their very own pure spring water. Each of their Devon beers has its own individual flavour and they take great pride in our artisan approach to producing them.

Back Beach is a light session pale ale using a blend of Goldings, Eureka and Northern Brewer hops. It has a wonderful floral nose with a crisp, clean taste and slightly dry finish.

Abbeyle Brewery Heathen 4.1% abv

In 1996, when Patrick Morton along with his father Hugh decided to pursue their mutual love of fine beer and put their faith and money into creating their very own brewery. 24 years on, Pat and his wife Sue are still very much at the helm at **Abbeyle Brewery** and have developed the business into a well-known Sheffield institution.
